

Tim Hadwen is the Assistant Deputy Minister, Education Labour Relations Division, Ministry of Education. The Division is responsible for representing the Crown in central bargaining under the School Boards Collective Bargaining Act.

Tim was the Assistant Deputy Minister of the Labour Relations Secretariat, in the Ministry of Government Services; the Secretariat was responsible for providing strategic analysis and advice concerning Broader Public Sector (BPS) labour relations.

Tim has been the Director of the Legal Services Branch of the Ministry of Government Services, responsible for providing legal advice and representation to the Government of Ontario acting as employer.

Previously, Tim was the Director of the Legal Services Branch of the Ontario Ministry of Labour, and, prior to joining government, he was General Counsel to the Ontario Public Service Employees Union, manager of the litigation and membership benefits departments of the Ontario Nurses Association, and in private practice, a partner in the law firm of Cavalluzzo Shilton McIntyre Cornish.
