The project will be an opportunity for a student to gain hands-on experience of behind-the-scenes work at a small museum. The project will also allow the intern to enhance their critical thinking skills and gain an understanding of behind-the-scenes work in the cultural heritage sector.

The goal of this project is to move closer to completing the Museum's inventory, which will benefit the progress of the long-term goal of providing better overall management of the Museum's collection.
