THE RECTOR

The <u>Queen's University Rector</u> is a student, elected by all students for a three-year term. The Rector tradition was passed to Queen's from the University of Edinburgh, with the first Rector taking office in 1913 and the first student Rector taking office in 1969. The Rector of Queen's is the third officer of the University, after the Chancello r and Principal.

The central role of the Rector is to act as an advocate and a facilitator of dialogue regarding students' needs, opinions, and views with the university's senior administration. The Office of the Rector is an important resource for the Queen's student community in helpin g them understand the university's administrative structure and how to obtain student -specific resources and services.
