Discussion on new policy initiatives from Bruce Bell:

Currently reviewing the safety policies such as First Aid Kits and AED

Seeking any members wanting to do First Aid/AED training. Sarah Anderson, Brandon Ruck, Alex Amodeo are interested. We should have 1 member from each unit to cover all areas. 3rd party training by St. John's Ambulance or Red Cross. We should include a certain number of grad students for training. Any First aid training that expired in 2020 has been extended to Dec 2021.
