- 1. A process of annual meetings has been established with cognate departmental faculty teach Arts and Sci**snoe**rses in the undergraduate nursing programs. This process will significantly improve both curricular management and communication with teachers external to the School.
- 2. A system foronitoring student progression through graduate programs has been established. The process includes requirements that students provide annual written progress reports, that there are regulars aparts into meetings to monitor progress and that supervisors regularly submit written reports on student progress to the Gradu Program Committee.
