Senate Operations Review Committee Report to Senate – Meeting of February 26, 2009

Recommendation to establish a Principal's Ad Hoc Committee to d'atte Disclosure Policy"

Introduction

In November, 2008 Senator J. Welsh submitted a Motion to Senate requesting that a committee be established to draft a policy on the protection of Whistleebls. The Senate Agenda Committee determined that such a policy didlieosolely within the purview of Senate and therefore, did not include the submissionthe November Senate Agenda. The issue was referred to SORC and it was asked to determine Motion could be dealt with through another mechanism.

Review of the Issues

The issue was reviewed at SORC's January 1/03, Fæbruary 6, 2009 meetings. To assist SORC with its deliberations, other Canadian univities were surveyed regarding whistleblower policies, their formation anidirisdictional authority.

Analysis and Discussion

The following points summarizate Committee's discussion:

- x SORC agreed with the Senate Agenda Citteenthat a safe disclosure policy was broader than the function of the Senate. Therefore, a university-wide committee should be struck with a composition that repents the whole of the University;
- x Once drafted the policy shoulded approved by the Senate and ratified by the Board of Trustees;
- x The committee and its Chair should established by the Principal;
- x As required, the Principal's Ad Hoc Corittee should have the authority to consult with other individuals and offices on campus to draw upon their expertise. This may include the Office of the Vice-Principal (Irhan Resources), the Human Rights Office, the Academic Integrity Advisor to the Ce-Principal (Academic), the School of Graduate Studies and Research and Legal Counsel;
- x The Ad Hoc Committee should complete its **blef**iations within a reasonable amount of 0003 Tc -0.0003 Tw 15.31 0 Tunivers

Conclusions/Recommendations

The Senate Operations Review Committee remmends that the Senate approve the recommendation to establish a Principal's AdHoc Committee to draft a "Safe Disclosure Policy" as outlined in Appendix A.
