



The Senate Educational Equity Committee is responsible for academic equity-related policy in all matters pertaining to the academic mission of the University.

The responsibilities of the Committee include:

- reviewing and, where necessary, recommending revision to existing academic policy or the creation of new policy related to educational equity;
- monitoring and reporting to Senate on the effectiveness of the University in the implementation and administration of educational equity-related policy;
- the initiation and execution of research, as required, to inform the development of or the implementation of recommendations regarding educational equity-related policy;
- setting up subcommittees or task forces and inviting such representatives necessary to ensure the participation of equity interest groups and Queen in the work of the Committee;
