## Proof of Personal Identification

Date of birth

Examples of acceptabled entification include:

- x passport
- x citizenship card
- x permanent resident (PR) card
- x Indian Status Card or Indigenous Membership Card

# Physical Distancing

Capacity restrictions requiring two etre distancing are not required if the meprotocols described above or events and meetings with food or drink are in place.
